What is O.P.K?

O.P.K is a culturally appropriate wrap around support system that nurtures and supports marginalized, at-risk, Indigenous young adults and their families

Evaluation Questions

- 2. How can the program improve this approach? (strengths & weaknesses)
- 3. What are the social and economic impacts? (positive/negative)



What are the benefits to participants

- ◆Completion of parole/probation
- ◆Establish a job/training/education
- ◆ Receive shelter/obtain stable housing
- ◆Perceived achievement of individual goals
- ◆ Reduced gang involvement activity
- ◆ Positive family connections/community connections
- ◆ Attendance at ceremonies
- ◆Self initiating community/cultural engagement
- ◆Obtaining ID's
- ◆Self initiated/ # of staff initiated counseling/crisis support.



How can the program improve this approach?

- ◆ Participant satisfaction
 - Access
 - Referrals made
 - Support
 - Relationship w/ support workers
 - Responsiveness
 - Flexibility
 - Culturally appropriateness
- Supports for staff/volunteers (tools, resources)
- ◆Continuity/follow-up
- ◆Connections made w/ support worker
- ◆Increased sense of holistic supports



What are the social, economic impacts?

- ◆Decreased system involvement (e.g. justice, CFS)
- ◆ Decreased cost to systems
- ◆Increased labour supply connections to workforce
- ◆Partnerships with community
- ◆Civic engagement
- ◆ Revitalizing culture
